

## *Chores List by Age*

### ***Littles (toddlers and pre-k):***

- Putting items in the trash
- Putting items in the sink
- Helping carry groceries in/put away with your prompting
- Putting their shoes away
- Putting their clothes in the hamper
- Helping pick out what they are wearing today (give them a choice between pants, shirts, socks, shoes, hair bows)
- Cleaning up their toys
- Putting their books away
- Helping you get the mail and they can carry it inside; putting the junk mail in the trash
- Wiping up spills
- Helping wipe down the table/counters
- Helping make meals - putting food items on their plate, helping stir/mix
- Putting their clothes away with your prompting
- Helping feed the pets
- Watering outdoor plants
- Helping vacuum, mop, swiffer
- Helping take the dog/s for a walk (i.e. holding the leash with you)

### ***Kiddos (have started Kindergarten and older):***

- Chores from above as well as...
- Matching socks, putting their laundry away
- Helping put dishes away
- Helping wash dishes
- Taking out the trash
- Helping make their bed
- Putting laundry into the washer, moving it to the dryer, helping fold
- Putting mail in the mailbox and lifting the flag
- Watering plants indoor and outdoor
- Wash windows and sliding doors
- Rake leaves, pull weeds

### ***Older Kiddos (later Elementary schooler):***

- Loading and unloading dishwasher
- Mopping floors
- Making snacks and easy meals (like a salad)
- Pack their lunch
